



FOUR-FOR-FOUR EA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS CROWNED

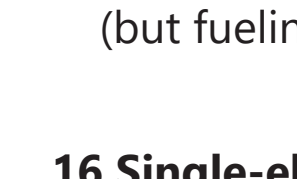

U13 (2012) • U14 (2011) • U15 (2010) • U19 (2007/6)

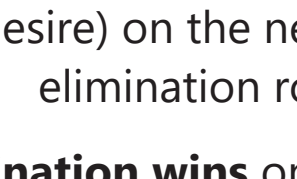

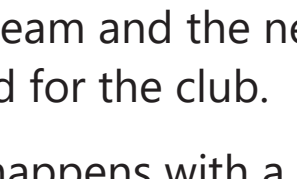
ROUND OF 16
Match Day 1



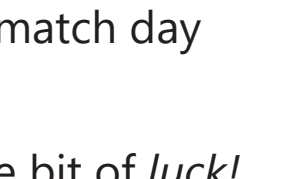
QUARTERFINALS

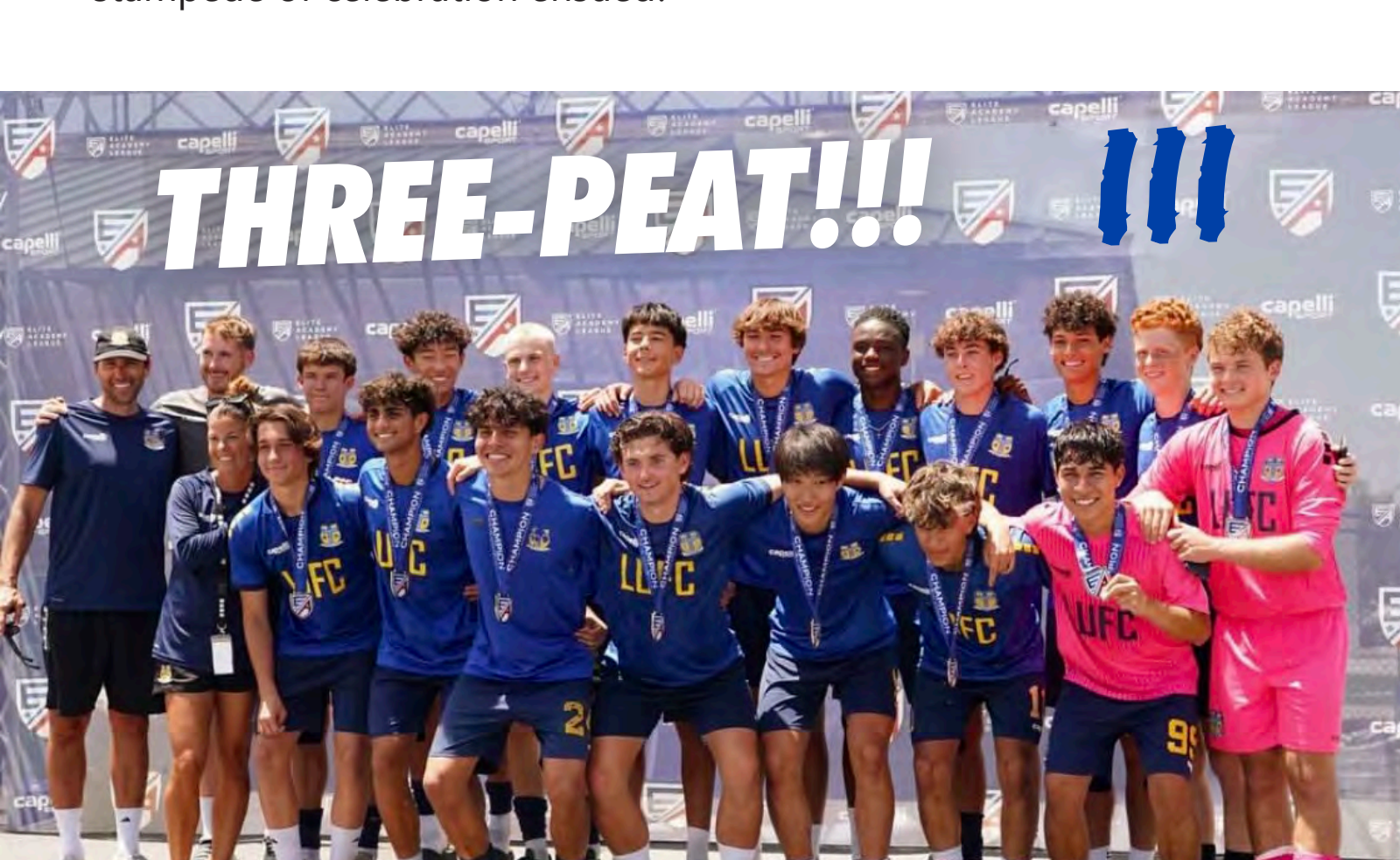
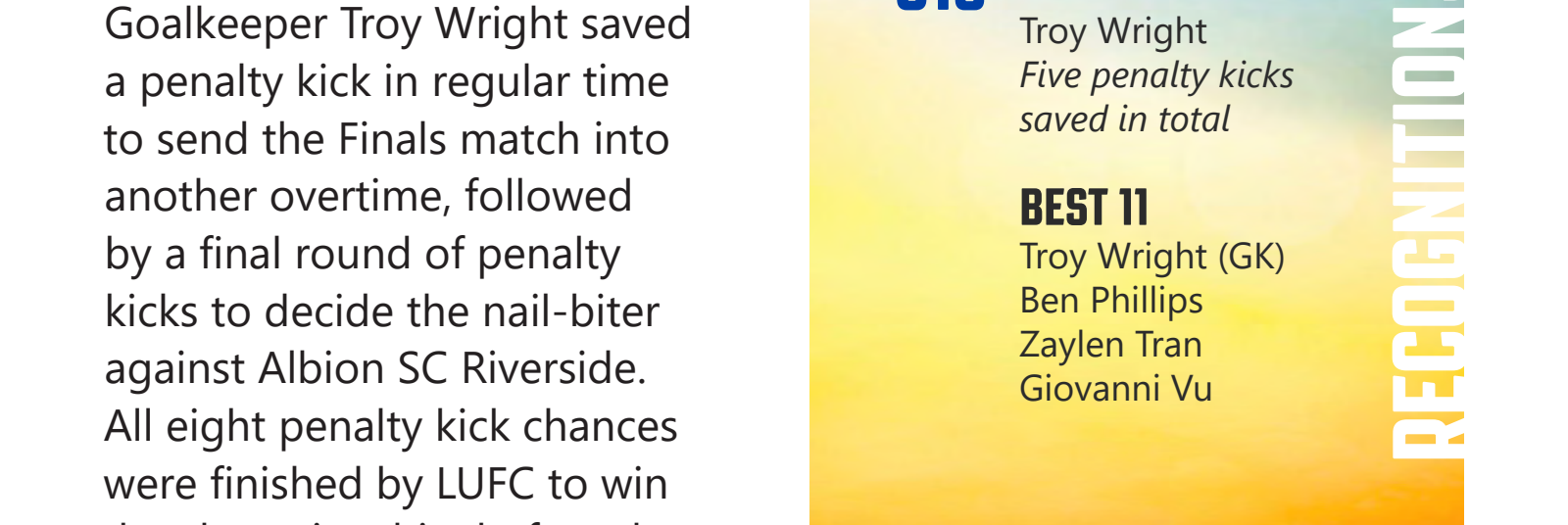
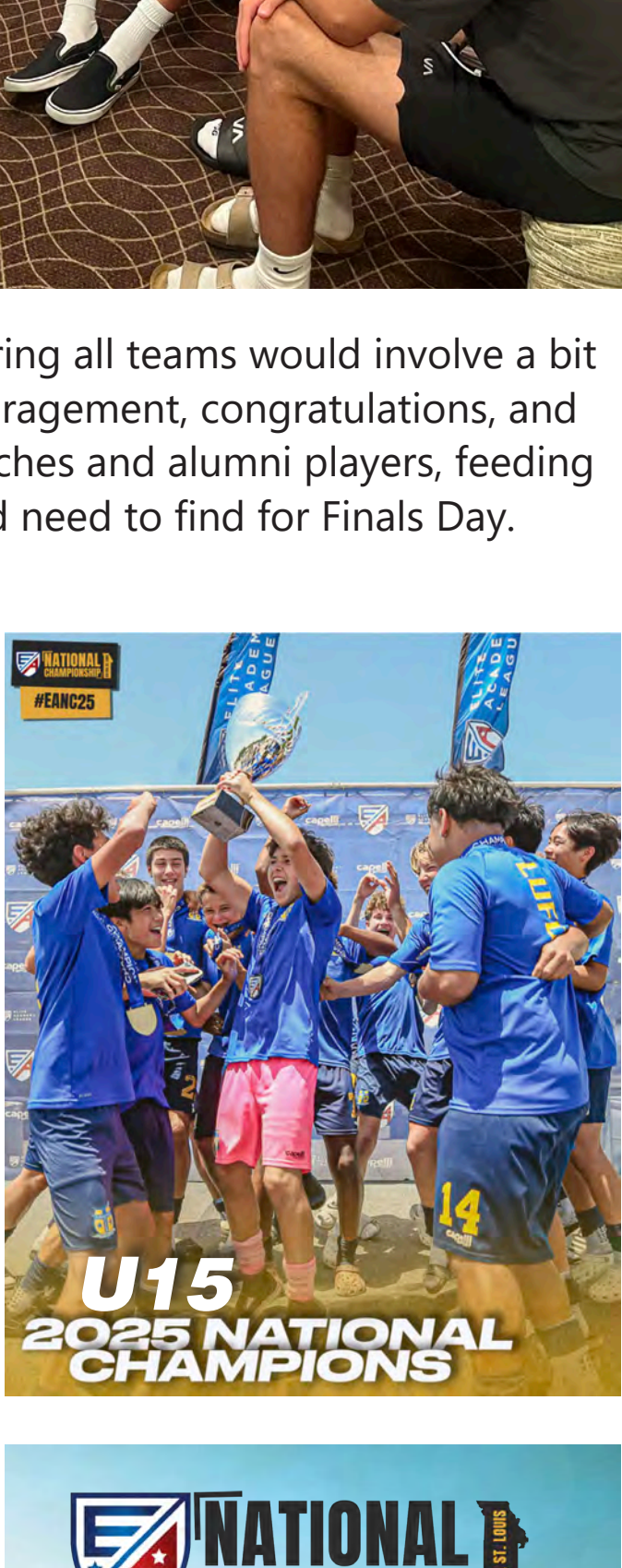
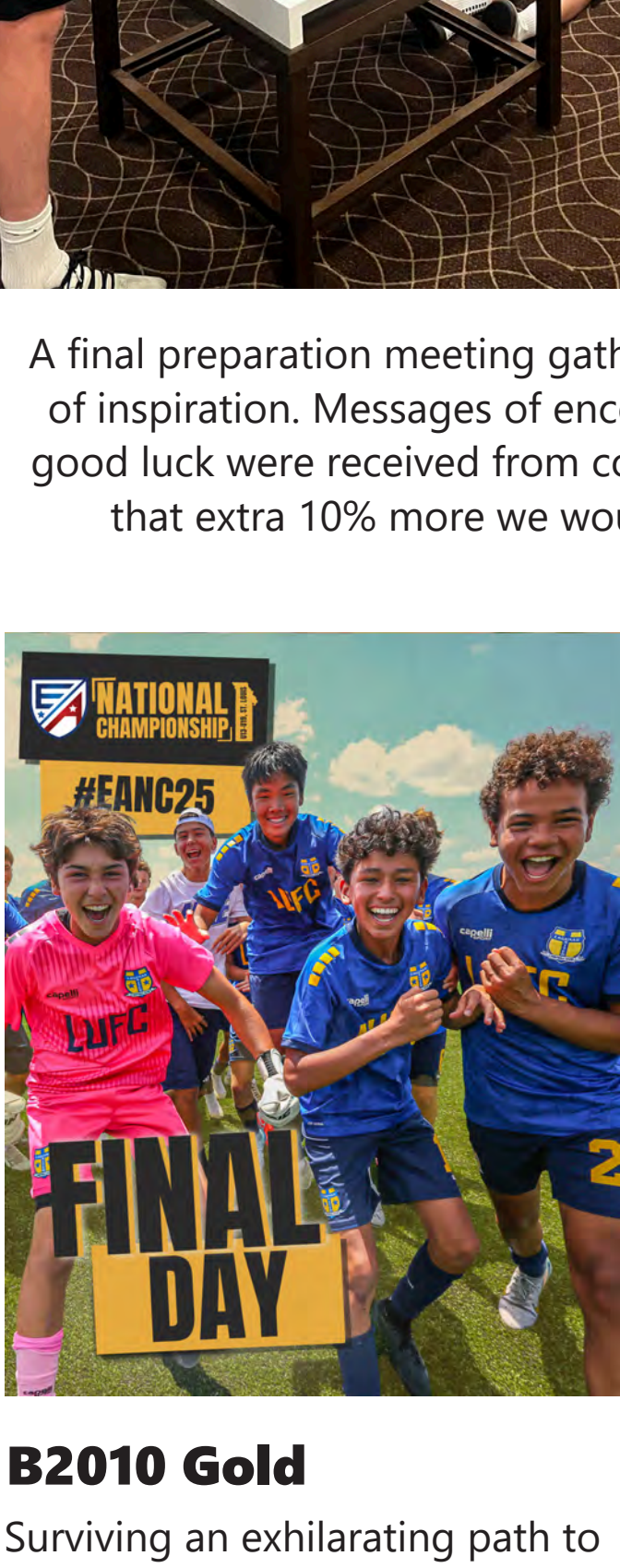
B2012 Blue

A first-time trip to EA Nationals for the youngest age division championship, B2012 Blue team marched through Nationals only conceding one goal across four matches, demonstrating a consistent and dominant style of play and possession.

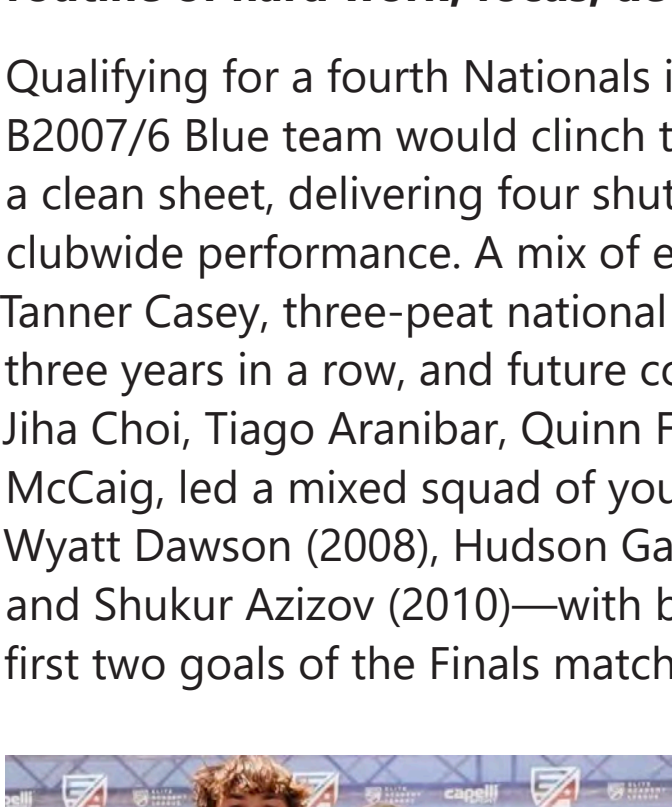


B2011 Blue

Finishing on a near perfect, undefeated Southwest Division league season, B2011 Blue team advanced their way into a Finals derby and win over Albion SC Santa Monica, conceding only two goals across four matches.

B2010 Gold

Surviving an exhilarating path to the title, B2010 Gold team won in penalty kicks through the Round of 16, Semifinals, and Finals. Goalkeeper Troy Wright saved a penalty kick in regular time to send the Finals match into another overtime, followed by a final round of penalty kicks to decide the nail-biter against Albion SC Riverside. All eight penalty kick chances were finished by LUFC to win the championship, before the celebration ensued!



B2007/6 Blue

How do you win championship titles back-to-back-to-back? By owning a standard of excellence and maintaining a consistent routine of hard work, focus, determination, and DESIRE.

Qualifying for a fourth Nationals in the oldest age division, B2007/6 Blue team would clinch the U19 championship title with a clean sheet, delivering four shutout matches to cap off a perfect clubwide performance. A mix of experienced players including Tanner Casey, three-peat national champion named to EA's "BEST 11" three years in a row, and future college commits Eduardo Moreno, Jiha Choi, Tiago Aranibar, Quinn Frye, Shaun Kim, and Maverick McCaig, led a mixed squad of younger talented players: Wyatt Dawson (2008), Hudson Garner (2009), Carter Biondolillo (2010), and Shukur Azizov (2010)—with both Carter and Shukur scoring the first two goals of the Finals match.
