The Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup—U.S. Soccer’s Club Championship—has crowned a champion since 1914 in every year except 2020 and 2021. The historic tournament is conducted on a single-game-knockout basis and open to all professional and amateur teams affiliated with U.S. Soccer. In 1999, the oldest ongoing national soccer competition in the United States was renamed to honor American soccer pioneer Lamar Hunt.
